

Luke 9:23

What's it About? The life, teaching and death of Jesus

Written to Whom? Theophilus and all who love God, between 63 and 70 AD

What's it About? The birth and growth of the Christian church

What's it About? Faith - what we should believe and how we should behave

Written to Whom? The church in Corinth, about 55 AD

What's it About? Paul addresses problems in the Corinthian church and answers questions

Memory Verse: *Christ is like a single body, which has many parts; it is still one body, even though it is made up of different parts.*

Written to Whom? The church in Corinth, about 55-57 AD

What's it About? Paul defends his actions and shares his personal experience in the church

Written to Whom? The churches in southern Galatia, about 49 AD

What's it About? How new, non-Jewish believers would fit into the system of Jewish law

Galatians 5:22-23a

Written to Whom? The church in Philippi, about 61 AD

What's it About? Joy in suffering, in serving others, in believing and in giving

Written to Whom? The church in Colosse, about 60 AD

What's it About? Don't try to blend man-made ideas with the true gospel of Jesus Christ

Colossians 3:23

Written to Whom? The church in Thessalonica, about 51 AD

What's it About? Being faithful to God, and expectant of Christ's return

Memory Verse: *And so encourage one another and help one another, just as you are now doing.*

Written to Whom? The church in Thessalonica, about 51 AD

What's it About? A follow-up to Paul's first letter, explaining Christ's second coming

Memory Verse: *May the Lord himself, who is our source of peace, give you peace at all times and in every way. The Lord be with you all.*
2 Thessalonians 3:16

Written By: Paul

Written to Whom? Timothy, about 64 AD

What's it About? Encouragement and instruction for a young church leader

Memory Verse: *Do not let anyone look down on you because you are young, but be an example for the believers in your speech, your conduct, your love, faith, and purity.*
1 Timothy 4:12

LETTERS

Written By: Paul

Written to Whom? Timothy, about 66-67 AD

What's it About? Paul's final words of wisdom for Timothy before his own death

Memory Verse: *All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful for teaching the truth, rebuking error, correcting faults, and giving instruction for right living*
2 Timothy 3:16

Written By: Paul

Written to Whom? Titus (a Greek believer), about 64 AD

What's it About? Instructions for Titus to oversee churches in Crete

Memory Verse: *Remind your people to submit to rulers and authorities, to obey them, and to be ready to do good in every way.*
Titus 3:1

Written By: Paul

Written to Whom? Philemon (a member of the Colossian church), about 60 AD

What's it About? Paul asks Philemon to forgive his slave Onesimus, who had run away

Memory Verse: *So, if you think of me as your partner, welcome him back just as you would welcome me.*

Hebrews 11:1

Written By: James, the brother of Jesus

Written to Whom? Jewish Christians living outside Palestine, about 49 AD

What's it About? True faith goes beyond simple belief, and results in loving actions

Memory Verse: *Do not deceive yourselves by just listening to his word; instead, put it into practice.*
James 1:22

Written By: Peter

Written to Whom? Jewish Christians forced to leave Jerusalem, about 62-64 AD

What's it About? Encouragement for suffering Christians

Memory Verse: *Be alert, be on watch! Your enemy, the Devil, roams around like a roaring lion, looking for someone to devour.*
1 Peter 5:8

Written By: Peter

Written to Whom? The whole Christian church, about 67 AD

What's it About? Warning about false teachers, encouragement to grow in faith.

Memory Verse: *But continue to grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To him be the glory, now and forever! Amen.*
2 Peter 3:18

Written By: John, the apostle

Written to Whom? Several non-Jewish Christian churches, about 85-90 AD

What's it About? A blueprint of faith to counter false teachings.

Memory Verse: *But if we confess our sins to God, he will keep his promise and do what is right: he will forgive us our sins and purify us from all our wrongdoing.*
1 John 1:9

Written By: John, the apostle

Written to Whom? "The elect lady" and her children, about 90 AD

What's it About? Christ is truth and love. Beware false teachers.

Memory Verse: *This love I speak of means that we must live in obedience to God's commands. The command, as you have all heard from the beginning, is that you must all live in love.*
2 John 6

Written By: John, the apostle

Written to Whom? Gaius, a well-known member of the church, about 90 AD

What's it About? Encouraging faithful service and condemning pride

Memory Verse: *My dear friend, you are so faithful in the work you do for other Christians, even when they are strangers.*

Written By: Jude, younger brother of Jesus and James

Written to Whom? Christians everywhere, about 65 AD

What's it About? Warning against false teaching and turning away from Christ

Memory Verse: *and keep yourselves in the love of God, as you wait for our Lord Jesus Christ in his mercy to give you eternal life.*
Jude 21

Written to Whom? The seven churches in Asia, about 95 AD

What's it About? Prophetic visions of hope and warning about the end-times and Christ's return
