This year we would love to invite you to come on a prayer puzzle adventure with us.

Each day you will get a different **mosaic square tile** to pray with. You can colour it in, write prayers and journal over it, using the different lines and sections to pray for different things on your heart. Each new tile will be connected to the previous one, and over the 11 days, it will start to reveal a special Pentecost picture. There are no rules as to how you decorate or use your puzzle tiles, however you may like to think how the colours join with the sections next to it.

Each day, there is a mosaic tile, a **Bible verse**, and a **blessing** to match the theme of the day. The blessings have been kindly written by Archdeacon Pete Watson from Masterton.

- Scissors








Day 5 / Monday 25 May

CELEBRATE




Day 9 / Friday 29 May
